



## Course Outline

PRINCE2 is a scalable, flexible project management methodology designed to provide a framework covering most disciplines and projects. It uses a structured process-based approach for effective project management and is a best-practice framework for managing projects of any size.

PRINCE2 is by far the world's most widely used project management methodology, used by both the public and private sectors. It has been endorsed as the methodology to be used by Queensland Government for all ICT enabled projects.

## Key Features

PRINCE2 is designed to be used on any type of project in any environment. It contains a complete set of concepts and project management processes which are the minimum requirements for a properly run and managed project.

## The key features of PRINCE2 are:

- Focus on business justification
- A sound governance structure
- Product-based planning approach
- Effective controls at all levels within a project
- Stages based on management decision points
- Flexibility to be applied at any level appropriate to a project.

## Learning Outcomes

Following the course, delegates will be able to organise, plan and control projects quickly and effectively in accordance with the PRINCE2 methodology. Senior Management will be able to make decisions on project initiation and at critical points throughout the lifecycle of the project, with an eye on benefits to be realised and the required return on investment.



### Pre-requisites

Delegates should have some experience of project management or at least the project environment.

### Duration

Five days with the Foundation Exam on day three. The Practitioner Exam is offered at the end of the course.

The course will be a mixture of input and practical sessions, delivered by a PRINCE2 accredited practitioner and trainer. The workshops are designed to impart relevant skills and knowledge by working through real-life examples and scenarios.
