Aims of Seminar

To introduce those new to Project Management to the concepts and some key principles associated with achieving successful results through structured project management.

Scope

Although the contents of this session comply with the principles of “Projects in a Controlled Environment” (PRINCE2), this is not a formal PRINCE2 training course, for which we offer Foundation and Practitioner level training and examinations.

This seminar is an ideal introduction for those involved in project management in their organisation and who might attend a later accredited PRINCE2 training course for formal training.

PRINCE2 is a structured methodology providing an organisation with a standard approach to the management of projects.

The methodology has proven and established best practice in project management. It is widely recognised and understood, and so provides a common language for all participants in the project.

PRINCE2 provides benefits to the organisation, as well as the managers and directors of the project, through the controllable use of resources and the ability to manage risk more effectively.

PRINCE2 enables projects to have:

- A controlled and organised start and end
- Regular reviews of progress against plan and against the Business Case
- Flexible decision points
- Automatic management control of any deviations from the plan
- Involvement of management and stakeholders at the right time and place during the project
- Good communication channels between the project, project management, and the organisation.
