

Management of Risk

Risk management is a vital element of managing change through projects and ensuring business as usual is managed effectively as part of corporate governance.

M_o_R®

M_o_R is the UK Government Management of Risk guide, linked to portfolio, program and project management through PRINCE2, MSP and MoP. This course provides international certification in Risk Management. You can register for a Foundation Course (3 days) including the Foundation exam, or the full 5 day Practitioner Course. This course uses the new M_o_R 2010 Manual and exams.

Pre-requisites

None. M_o_R is appropriate for managers of any discipline involved at all levels, but attendees should have an understanding of how their business operates. Delegates receive the M_o_R manual prior to the course. The Practitioner exam can only be taken when a candidate has passed the Foundation exam.

Benefits

The course will benefit all managers who have some responsibility for the effective management of risk within their organisation. It is particularly aimed at:

- Risk managers who may be responsible for establishing organisation-wide processes and procedures for risk management
- Programme managers who need to develop structured approaches to management of risk on major change programmes
- Project managers wishing to manage project risk more effectively
- Operations managers responsible for day-to-day business who wish to reduce operational risk
- Consultants wishing to understand the latest OGC guidance and gain the new qualifications in order to successfully apply the method for their clients.

The course is delivered in an entertaining and highly interactive manner with real life examples used to illustrate the subject. There is a high degree of participation, examination preparation and practice.

Duration

The course is an intensive, five-day, practically based event. The Foundation exam will be held on day four and the Practitioner exam on day five.

Foundation Qualification

- The Foundation qualification focuses on the principles, approach and processes of M_o_R.
- The exam consists of 75 multiple choice questions to be answered in one hour. It is a closed-book examination and has a pass mark of 50%.

Practitioner Qualification

- The Practitioner qualification focuses in depth on the principles, approach and processes of M_o_R.
- The exam is based on a Case Study, with multiple choice questions to be answered in 3 hours.
- It is an open-book examination and has a pass mark of 50%.
